Storrs, CT -- Dr. Richard L. Schwab, dean of the Neag School of Education at the University of Connecticut is the new president of the Council of Academic Deans from Research Institutions (CADREI), a national organization representing many of country's preeminent institutions of higher education. The group is dedicated to raising standards for teacher education and advancing education research.



Schwab is currently serving his 10th year as a dean at UConn. Previously, he'd served as education dean at Drake University in Des Moines, Iowa and spent another 10 years on the University of New Hampshire faculty. He is an active member of the National Commission on Teaching and America's Future and the American Association of Colleges of Teacher Education (AACTE). He teaches each summer at AACTE's New Deans Institute and is president of the AACTE's Connecticut chapter. He is a member of the New England Council of Presidents (NECOP) and has served as president and held several other offices of the Northeastern Educational Research Association.
