STORRS, CT -- Another impressive honor for one of the Neag School's young faculty members.

Dr. Michael Faggella-Luby, an assistant professor of special education in the Department of Educational Psychology, has been selected to receive the 2007 Annual Dissertation Award from the Council for Exceptional Children -- one of the field's most prestigious organization's. He will receive the award from the Council's Division of Learning Disabilities during the group's national conference in April. Last year, he received the 2006 Outstanding Researcher Award from the Council for Learning Disabilities.



Dr. Faggella-Luby's primary research interest focuses on embedding instruction in learning strategies into subject-area courses to improve reading comprehension for all levels of learners.

He is a former high school administrator and teacher. He earned his doctorate in special education at the University of Kansas and was a fellow at its Center for Research and Learning before joining the Neag faculty.
